1. WOMEN EMPOWERMENT

EMPOWERING WOMEN FOR LIVELIHOOD INITIATIVES IN TARIKERE TALUK. SUPPORTED BY MANOS UNIDAS, SPAIN - PROJECT NO: IND 74376

The programme is implemented in 6 Grama panchayaths viz., Kamanadurga, Lingadahalli, Mallenahalli, Nandi Battalu, Tigada and Thogarihankal. For a period of 6 months 40 girls and women received vocational training sessions on garment making and beautician course. 28 girls and women are self- employed, while 12 work for employers and earn a living. 55 widows have turned to animal husbandry as a source of income, earning between Rs.4000 and Rs.5000 per month to support their families. 3267 beneficiaries attended 92 training sessions and obtained knowledge on identifying skills and livelihood initiatives, Entrepreneur Awareness and Entrepreneur Development Programs, Domestic Violence, Women Atrocities, Women Rights, Time keeping and budgeting.



EMPOWERMENT OF ADOLESCENT GIRLS

SUPPORTED BY: FR. RAMON PINERO & TEAM, ONG. MADRE TERESA, SPAIN

598 students and teachers attended training sessions on the necessity of sanitary pads, how to use them, and how to dispose them. 598 students, instructors, domestic staff and the organization outreach volunteers received 750 packets of sanitary pads. 406 girls of Prema Jyothi Hr. Pry & High School, Kadur, Divya Jyothi Hr. Pry & High School, Marianagar, St. Francis Xaviers School, Magge and St. Loyola Hr. Pry & High School, Gadenahalli took part in the training sessions of food and nutrition training sessions and received food grains like Horse gram, Green gram, Ground nut and Peanuts

EMPOWERING OF SOCIO ECONOMICALLY DISADVANTAGED WOMEN IN KARNATAKA SUPPORTED BY B.H. MISEREOR, GERMANY THROUGH KROSS, BENGALURU.

The program is implemented in Hassan and Arsikere Taluks of Hassan District. 118 women self help groups and 7 cluster federations and one district federation are functioning. 32 training sessions were conducted. 2072 women increased their knowledge on Climatic Change, Roof Water Harvesting, Existing Acts/ Laws, Domestic Violence, Women Atrocities, Women Rights, Right Based Approach, Leadership and Personality Development, Health and Hygiene and COVID 19 norms. 15 women out of 32 emerged as women leaders at the local governance level. Three cases against women atrocities were solved in Arsikere Mahaila Santvana Kendra. Memorandum was submitted by the SHG members to the Deputy Commissioner, Hassan and to the Honorable Chief Minister of Karnataka against opening of an arrack shop in the Gadenahalli village.



COVID 19-CORONA –FOOD AND MEDICAL KITS TO 500 AFFECTED AND MIGRANT UNDERPRIVELEDGED FAMILIES PROJECT NO.2020-1-39829

There was no treatment or vaccine available in the aftermath of the COVID 19 pandemic, the entire human race suffered. A total of 18 public awareness programmes were held. 730 people were educated about the pandemic and the government regulations. Dry ration packs and medical kits were given to 750 households.

The Director of CMSSS Rev. Fr. Shantharaj R addressed the students, teachers and the parents about COVID 19 pandemic and the norms laid down by the government to be followed strictly to avoid the infection. On this occasion we distributed dry ration kits and face masks to 147 students.

ProVision Asia Bengaluru supported with 40 wheel chairs and dry ration kits for the people with disabilities and constructed 10 ramps to the schools.



GARV-SE CENTER, CMSSS: SUPPORTED BY ENABLE INDIA, BENGALURU:

Organised 12 primary workshops for 268 beneficiaries. 111 people took part in the 6 committee meetings held for the SHG leaders, Grama Panchayath staff, Auto Richshaw owners and CMSSS staff. 48 people were present for 2 secondary workshops conducted for Government officials, School Headmasters, Rotary Club Members, CMSSS and Grama Panchayath Staff. EDP trainings were conducted for 55 PwDs of Hassan, Alur and Sakleshpura taluk for 10 days at RSETI, Hassan. Rs.5000/- each was given to 16 PwDs and Rs. 6400/- each was given to 2 PwDs as an initial investment money to start a income generation activities.



5. HEALTH

SPARSHA – INSTILLING HOPE - SUPPORTED BY CARITAS INDIA, NEW DELHI, INDIA.

It is a Campaign against the deadly illness called Cancer. 40 villages of Hassan & Chikmagalur districts are covered in this program reaching out to 2500 people and created awareness on cancer the deadly disease. Men, Women, Youth and children are sensitized to adopt a healthy life style. 46 cancer patients are identified, 2 of them are referred to Fr.Mullers Hospital, Mangalore and 2 of them to Malnad Hospital, Shimoga. Few of them are sent to Dharmasthala Ayurvedic centre for the preliminary treatment. Rallys were conducted at Hassan, Gadenahalli, Chikmagalur, Balehonnur and the beneficiaries participated in the Cancer day observation.



NATURAL CALAMITIES

1. NEW HOUSE CONSTRUCTION SUPPORT BY THE ARCHDIOCESE OF BANGALORE

Rt. Rev. Dr. Peter Machado, the Arch Bishop of Bangalore and his team, Rt. Rev. Dr. T Anthony Swamy, Bishop of the diocese of Chikmagalur visited the houses of the beneficiary families and inaugurated the new houses and handed over the keys to the beneficiaries on 29th January 2021. His Excellency thanked the donors and requested the beneficiaries to pray for the intentions of the donors. The delegates present acknowledged the sacrifices of the Arch diocese of Bangalore



8. JEEVAN JYOTHI FEDERATION



Jeevan Jyothi Federation is a sister concern of CMSSS which basically caters to the educational, Social, cultural and economic needs of the women and their families. It has a membership of 5504 women with 426 self help groups in the two civil districts of Hassan and Chikmagalur. It has 17 members as its board of directors and they function independently with the guidance and support of the Director of CMSSS, Fr. Shantharaj R.

The federation has taken up an issue of violence against a women who was sleeping on the Pavement in Hassan on 24-08-2020. She was abused and brutally murdered. A Memorandum was submitted to the District Commissioner, Superintendent of Police, Women and Child welfare department, Human Rights commission, Hassan and a copy to the Chief Minister of Karnataka on 28-08-2020. The Police force of Hassan took the issue seriously and arrested the culprit.



The eligible beneficiaries were given financial assistance to start income generation activities with low rate of service charges to be repaid in equal monthly installments for productive and Non productive purposes.



9. SAVE A FAMILY PLAN TRUST, DIOCESE OF CHIKMAGALUR SUPPORTED BY SAVE A FAMILY PLAN CANADA THROUGH SAVE A FAMILY PLAN TRUST INDIA, KERALA.

FAMILY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (FDP):



The program is implemented in 3 regions viz. Hassan, Chikmagalur and Balehonnur. 240 partner families are supported for a period of 6 years with training sessions, meetings and financial assistance to take up income generation activities, renovations and repairs of their houses, construction of new houses, education of children and medical

treatment. 1381 partner families are self-reliant and lead a dignified life. 203 partner families have taken up small business initiative, purchase of groceries, agriculture and animal husbandry.
